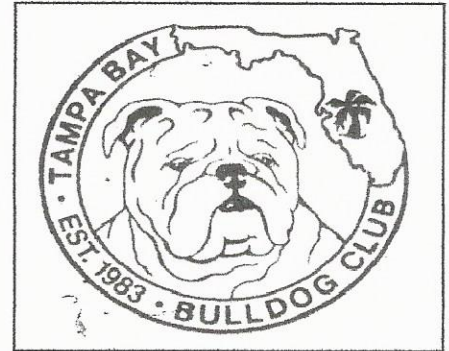

TAMPA BAY BULLDOG CLUB CODE OF ETHICS



This Code is established in accordance with the objective of the T.B.B.C. It is presented as a guideline for the use of Club members when buying, breeding, selling and exhibiting Bulldogs. Violators of this Code of Ethics will be subject to prompt action under Club Grievance and Charge Procedures.

1. Abide by the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tampa Bay Bulldog Club, the Bulldog Club of America, and the rules of the American Kennel Club.
2. Keep accurate breeding records, registration papers and pedigrees.
3. Furnish records to each buyer of all shots and wormings, FDA Health Certificate, pedigree, and AKC registration and transfer documents, unless written agreement is made at the time of sale that papers will be withheld.
4. All services and sales agreements shall be mutually agreed upon, stated in writing and signed by all parties involved.
5. Maintain the best possible standards of canine health, cleanliness and care.
6. All advertising shall be honest and not in any way be misrepresentative, fraudulent or misleading.
7. All dogs offered/bitches accepted for stud service shall be in good health, free from communicable diseases and disqualifying, genetic faults, and registered with the AKC or a Registry recognized by the AKC.
8. No stud dog will be bred to any bitch whose owner is directly involved with any puppy broker, puppy mill, or litter lot sales.
9. No Bulldogs will be sold to commercial facilities, puppy brokers, pet shops, puppy mills nor agents thereof.
10. All members shall conduct themselves at all times in such a manner as to reflect credit on the sport of AKC purebred dog showing and Bulldogs, in particular.
